ORDINANCE #713

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 7 OF THE FRENCHTOWN CODE ESTABLISHING A SPEED LIMIT OF 25 MILES PER HOUR ON TRENTON AVENUE IN THE BOROUGH OF FRENCHTOWN

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Borough of Frenchtown, in the County of Hunterdon, as follows:

Chapter 7 of the Code of the Borough of Frenchtown is hereby amended to add the following:

Section 7-29 Speed limits

That the speed limits for both directions of traffic along the following named street be established as follows:

Name of Street

Location

Speed Limit

Trenton Avenue

Between Bridge Street and
Route 29 (entire length)

Speed Limit

25 MPH

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED THAT:

Regulatory and Warning signs shall be erected and maintained to effect the above designated speed limit as authorized by the New Jersey Department of Transportation.

This ordinance shall take effect upon approval by the Commissioner of Transportation, final passage and publication in accordance with law.
