BOROUGH OF FRENCHTOWN RESOLUTION #2011-74

Resolution to adopt the Hunterdon County All Hazards Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan

- WHEREAS, the Hunterdon County Department of Public Safety, Division of Emergency Management and 9-1-1 Coordination has been engaged with the State of New Jersey, Office of the Attorney General, Department of Law and Public Safety, Division of the State Police in conducting the Northern Delaware River Region All Hazards Pre-Disaster Mitigation Planning process pursuant to a FY 08 Pre-Disaster Mitigation (PM D) Planning Grant; and
- *WHEREAS*, the purpose of the PDM planning process was to develop all-hazards mitigation plans for the four counties of the Northern Delaware River Region, namely Sussex, Warren, Hunterdon and Mercer, and all municipalities within the said four counties; and
- WHEREAS, the period of performance to develop the PMD Plans with a six month extension was from January 9, 2009 through June 30,2011; and
- *WHEREAS*, the Sussex County Sheriff's Office, Division of Emergency Management and 9-1-1 Coordination took the lead role in coordinating the development of all-hazards mitigation plans for all four counties and their municipalities through James Lee Witt Associates; and
- WHEREAS, the spending plan included a 25% in-kind match in the form of non-supplanted employee salaries, wages and benefits, and expenses related to the planning process; and
- WHEREAS, said 25% in-kind match was more than achieved by contributions of in-kind services from all four counties and approved by the New Jersey State Police, Hazards Mitigation Unit; and
- WHEREAS, the New Jersey State Police, Emergency Management Section, Hazards Mitigation Unit, approved said plans and forwarded them to the Federal Emergency Management Agency, Region 2, New York City; and
- WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency, Region 2, has approved all plans developed under the FEMA grant; and
- WHEREAS, all participating municipalities are urged to draft a similar resolution to adopt the plan.
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Borough of Frenchtown does hereby adopt the Hunterdon County All Hazards Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan (on file in Clerk's Office) directing applicable county agencies to pursue appropriate PDM project funding; and

BOND ORDINANCE AMENDING BOND ORDINANCE #639 PROVIDING FOR THE INSTALLATION OF A PARK AND RIDE AND RELATED IMPROVEMENTS ALONG RIVER ROAD AND PROVIDING FOR A VILLAGE GREEN ALONG THE DELAWARE RIVER, FOR AND BY THE BOROUGH OF FRENCHTOWN, IN THE COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, NEW JERSEY, APPROPRIATING \$825,000 THEREFORE, AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$783,750 BONDS OR NOTES OF THE BOROUGH TO FINANCE PART OF THE COST THEREOF FINALLY ADOPTED ON MARCH 1, 2006 AMENDING THE IMPROVEMENTS TO INCLUDE THE BRIDGE STREET AND S. HARRISON STREET PROJECT BY THE BOROUGH OF FRENCHTOWN IN THE COUNTY OF HUNTERDON.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF FRENCHTOWN IN THE COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 3 (a): Is amended to read:

The improvement hereby authorized and the purpose for the financing of which the bonds are to be issued is for the installation of a park and ride and related improvement along River Road, the installation of a village green along the Delaware River, including the construction of pedestrian walkways and seating areas through the village green and all work necessary therefore and incidental thereto and additional improvements to Bridge Street and S. Harrison Street and all work necessary therefore and incidental thereto.

This bond ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by said Local Bond Law.

ORDINANCE #703

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE V, TITLED "ADMINISTRATION, PROCEDURES AND DEVELOPMENT APPLICATIONS", SECTION 504, TITLED "APPLICABILITY OF REQUIREMENTS" BY ADDING A NEW SUBSECTION 504F, TITLED "FIRE DEPARTMENT REVIEW AND INSPECTION", AND SECTION 508, TITLED "CHECKLISTS". SECTION 508A, TITLED "CHECKLIST OF DETAILS REQUIRED FOR PLANS", SUBDIVISION SECTION 508B. "CHECKLIST OF DETAILS FOR PRELIMINARY MAJOR SUBDIVISION PLATS AND PRELIMINARY SITE PLANS", SECTION 508C, TITLED REQUIRED "CHECKLIST OF DETAILS FOR FINAL SUBDIVISION PLATS AND FINAL SITE PLANS", AND SECTION 508D TITLED "CHECKLIST OF DETAILS REQUIRED FOR VARINACE APPLICATIONS" ALL TO PROVIDE FOR REVIEW AND COMMENT BY THE FIRE DEPARTMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Borough of Frenchtown Common Council, in the County of Hunterdon and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Article V, titled "Administration, Procedures and Development Applications", Section 504, titled "Applicability of Requirements" is hereby amended by adding a new Subsection 504F, titled "Fire Department Review and Inspection" as follows:

F. Fire Department Review and Inspection.

- 1. Prior to the holding of any public hearing on any application for major or minor subdivision, or major or minor site plan approval, or a variance approval, the applicant shall notify the Borough of Frenchtown Fire Department by following the Checklist requirements contained in Sections 508A, 508B, 508C and 508D to allow for review and comment by the Fire Department.
- 2. Prior to construction, the applicant shall furnish to the Fire Department one (1) copy of a general plat of such application on eight and five-tenths by eleven inch paper, in notebook form, with all road names and water supply points clearly delineated, suitable for use to assist in locating such development or locations therein under emergency circumstances.
- Prior to the issuance of a certificate 3. of occupancy for any major or minor subdivision, major or minor site plan, or variance approval, the applicant shall contact the Borough of Frenchtown Fire Department and permit the Fire familiarize their Department to inspect and unless the personnel with the site Department determines that there is no necessity for any such inspection.
- 4. The requirements of this Section 504F shall not apply to applications for approval of a sign.

Section 2. Section 508 titled "Checklists" is hereby amended by adding new Checklist items to Section 508A, titled "Checklist of Details Required for Minor Subdivision Plats", Section 508B, titled "Checklist of Details required for Preliminary Major Subdivision Plats and Preliminary Site Plans", Section 508C, titled "Checklist of Details Required for Final Major Subdivision Plats and Final Site Plans", and Section 508D, titled "Checklist of Details Required for Variance Applications", by adding to each Checklist the following:

One complete set of the application, plans and supporting documents in a separate envelope addressed to the Fire Department

for its review and comment.

Section 3. Severability. If any portion, paragraph, clause, sentence or phrase of this Ordinance is determined to be invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon publication of Notice of Final Passage in the manner provided by law.
