RESOLUTIONS

Resolution #2014-87 – Appoint Robert Young Jr. as Part-Time Patrolman for the Borough of Frenchtown

Subsequent to a brief discussion as to the number of hours the part-time patrolman will work, a motion was made by Jack Opdyke and seconded by Michele Liebttag to approve resolution #2014-87. The Mayor and Common Council approved by unanimous favorable roll call vote Resolution #2014-87 as follows:

RESOLUTION No. 2014-87

Appoint Robert Young Jr. as Part-Time Patrolman for the Borough of Frenchtown

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Frenchtown and the Frenchtown Borough Police Department shall require the services of a part-time patrolman beginning September 10, 2014 and

WHEREAS, the hours for the part time patrolman will not exceed 29.5 hours per week; and

WHEREAS, there will be no health benefits, no sick, vacation or compensatory time for this employee;

WHEREAS, the Frenchtown Borough Police Chief has reviewed Robert Young Jr.’s application, qualifications, and background check and has found them all to be acceptable, and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has determined that there are sufficient funds available in the Police Salary and Wage budget to pay for this employee.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Frenchtown, County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey, that, effective September 10, 2014, Robert Young Jr. be appointed as part-time patrolman at the hourly basis at \$18.36 per hour not to exceed 29.5 hours per week.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Patrolman Robert Young Jr. will serve a minimum of one year in the position of part-time patrolman as a probationary period being subject to probationary status.
