**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 7 OF THE FRENCHTOWN CODE
HANDICAPPED PARKING ON STREETS IN THE BOROUGH OF
FRENCHTOWN**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Borough of Frenchtown, in the County of Hunterdon, as follows:

Chapter 7 of the Code of the Borough of Frenchtown is hereby amended as follows:

Section 7-35.1 Handicapped Parking on Streets

In accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-197, the following on street location is added as a designated handicapped parking place. Handicapped parking spaces are for use by persons who have been issued special identification cards or plates or placards by the Motor Vehicle Commission or a temporary placard issued by the Chief of Police, or Public Safety Director or his/her designee. No other persons shall be permitted to park in these spaces.

Race Street	1	In front of 29 Race Street

This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication in accordance with law.
