

PROCLAMATION OF LOCAL DISASTER/EMERGENCY

To all citizens and persons within the municipality of Frenchtown Borough, NJ, and to all departments, divisions and bureaus of the municipality of Frenchtown Borough, New Jersey.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the powers vested in me by (Chapter 251 of the Laws of 1942 as amended and supplemented, N.J.S.A. App. A-9-30 et. Seq.:N.J.S.A. 40-48-1(6), and ordinances enacted pursuant thereto: N.J.S.A. 2C:33-1 et Seq.; -- whichever law or laws apply, and by ordinances adopted by Frenchtown Borough, I have declared that a local disaster/emergency exists within Frenchtown Borough; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid laws authorize the promulgation of such orders, rules and regulations, as are necessary to meet the various problems which have, or may be presented by such disaster/emergency; and

WHEREAS, by reason of the conditions which are imminent due to a snow/ice storm with anticipated impact on the Borough of Frenchtown, which may affect the health, safety, and welfare of the people of Frenchtown Borough; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that these areas of Frenchtown Borough should be then declared disaster areas, and further that certain measures must be taken to insure that the authorities will be unhampered in their efforts to maintain law and order as well as an orderly flow of traffic and further to protect the persons and property of the residents of Frenchtown Borough affected by the conditions; and

WHEREAS, the following areas are designated disaster areas: Within Frenchtown Borough NOW, THEREFORE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH the aforesaid laws, I do hereby promulgate and declare the following regulations shall be in addition to all other laws of the State of New Jersey and Frenchtown Borough:

1. Parking restrictions on Bridge St., Race St., and all county roads.
2. If deemed necessary alternate side parking for plowing and snow removal on all side roads.
- 3 The ability to remove vehicles hindering any snow removal operations.
4. The ability for the Frenchtown Police to tow or ticket any vehicle in violation of this order.
5. The ability for the Frenchtown Police to close any road within the borough limits.
6. This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect until such time as the Governor of the State of New Jersey determines that an emergency no longer exists.
