

Notification of Environmental Investigation and Cleanup
Former Frenchtown Ceramics Company Site
One 8th Street (Block 3/ Lot 1 and Block 10/Lot 1)

In accordance with New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) regulations for “Notification and Public Outreach”, Country Classics at Frenchtown, LLC is required to provide information relating to environmental conditions and remedial activities being conducted at the above referenced site.

Former operations conducted at the site include ceramics manufacturing. Chemicals associated with site operations include, but may not be limited to, metals, petroleum hydrocarbons, volatile organic compounds, and polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons and were initially detected in the soil and groundwater in 1975 and were the subject of remedial activities conducted by former owners/operators of the site. Recently, Country Classics at Frenchtown, LLC determined that petroleum hydrocarbon contamination has impacted surface water which migrated from the site. Remediation was conducted to address this issue and sampling will be conducted to confirm that all contamination has been remediated.

Country Classics at Frenchtown, LLC is conducting investigative and remedial activities in accordance with the requirements of the NJDEP to address the chemical contaminants detected. The person conducting the remediation has evaluated the environmental impacts from the site including the potential for the contamination from this site to affect drinking water wells and/or the quality of indoor air to ensure that any impacts from the contamination are promptly mitigated.
